US\$173 million award was annulled by an ICSID annulment committee and case resubmitted. Case settled after second merits hearing.
- | *Siag v. Egypt*, ICSID ARB/05/15 — ICSID case for violation of a BIT involving a hotel project. Obtained a favorable jurisdictional decision. Obtained award for \$130 million.
