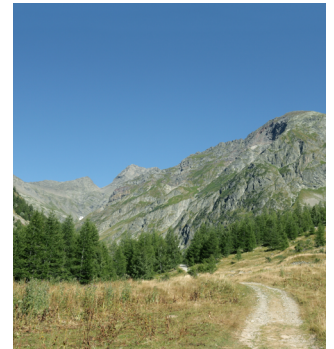

Supporting operators of industrial facilities in the management of impacts and risks:

- Supporting the design (audit of authorization applications, obtaining authorizations) and implementation (compliance audits, implementation of orders) of industrial projects;
- Analysing and controlling the impacts on health and the environment (water, air, biodiversity) as well as industrial risks (PPRT);

Intervention in the context of large infrastructure projects:

- Critical analysis of authorization applications;
- Advice on public law, planning and public ownership;
- Supporting strategic implementation of projects.

Representation in civil, administrative and criminal litigation:

- Monitoring of litigation before administrative courts under the legislation on classified facilities, water, waste, mining and quarrying as well as under EU regulations (REACH, Emissions Trading System ...);
- Managing of litigation initiated by residents related to neighborhood nuisances or by sellers / buyers of contaminated sites or in the context of environmental safeguards;
- Representation before criminal courts in the context of non-compliance, water pollution, damage to the environment or offenses related to waste transfer.
