

United States, Taiwan Announce New Critical Technology Supply Chain Framework To Focus On Semiconductors

The United States and Taiwan have established the Technology Trade and Investment Collaboration (“TTIC”), a new bilateral cooperation framework to strengthen critical technology supply chains. In a [statement](#), Commerce Secretary Gina M. Raimondo expressed “the United States’ continued interest in working together with Taiwan on issued of common commercial concern, particularly in the area of semiconductor supply chains and related eco-systems.” The parties will designate representatives at the bureau level to plan and convene the first meeting of the TTIC framework in the coming months in order to develop commercial programs and explore actions to strengthen critical supply chains involving semiconductors.
